### DxF Updates

- The Data Exchange Framework Policies and Procedures have been updated in line with Senate Bill (SB) 660. You can find the updated documents on [the new DxF website](#).

## 2026 DxF SUMMIT

- The 2026 Data Exchange Summit brings together the leaders, implementers, and partners advancing California's long-term vision for secure, connected, whole-person data sharing.
- Last year's Summit convened nearly 250 stakeholders from across California and was anchored by The Road to Whole-Person Care, inspired by the Data Exchange Framework (DxF) Roadmap, exploring how six foundational pillars come together in practice.

## STANDARDS ADVANCEMENT:

- As a reminder, the [Data Elements to Be Exchanged P&P v1.2](#) has been amended to update USCDI requirements to version 3 effective January 1, 2026,

as [recommended by the 2024 Standards Committee](#) and to align with federal health IT certification requirements.

- HCAI has published an amendment to [the Technical Requirements for Exchange P&P](#). This amendment is the result of deliberations of the Standards Committee in 2024, discussions with the Technical Advisory Committee and Implementation Advisory Committee in 2025, and recent public comment from our stakeholders. This amendment:
  - Removes requirements for the standards already specified by Nationwide Networks or Frameworks while clarifying that Nationwide Networks and Frameworks may be used to help meet DxF requirements;
  - Generalizes the language surrounding Event Notification;
  - Specifies the information that must be included in a request for Event Notifications;
  - Specifies the information and technical standards that must be used for Event Notifications; and
  - Clarifies the prohibition for using sex- and gender-related person attributes for Person Matching.

New provisions in the amended P&P become effective August 1, 2026. See the new amendment on the DxF website for more details.

- The Time is here! If your organization selected to Delay Exchange to 2026 in the Participant Directory, preparations for exchange should be in their final stages and ready to begin active exchange on or before January 31, 2026.
